Gaelchara

Bronnadh seacht ndamhachtain ar 14 duine faoin scéim Gaelchara ag ócáid i gCaifé Batch ar na Croisbhealaí, Co. Dhún na nGall an mhí seo caite. Is fiú €350 an duine gach damhachtain. Is í aidhm na scéime Gaelchara nó deis a sholáthar do fhoghlaimoirí Gaeilge chun feabhas a chur ar a c(h)uid scileanna teanga. Déanfar seo tré deis a thabhairt dóibh an Ghaeilge a chleachtadh mar theanga bheo i suíomh Gaeltachta. Chuige sin, tugtar deis don fhoghlaimoir achar ama a chaitheamh i gcomhlúadar cainteora dhúchais (an Gaelchara). I measc na ngníomhaíochtaí a roghaíodh i mbliana, tá: garradóireacht orgánach; ealaín faoin aer; drámaíocht; staidéar ar ábhar eaglasta; agus an amhránaíocht. Rinneadh 24 iarratas ina iomlán ar an scéim.

Winners of 'Gaelchara' grant award announced at special event.

The winners of the 2019 'Gaelchara' grant scheme were announced at a special ceremony in Café Batch, Falcarragh on Wednesday 29th of May last. Seven bursaries were presented to fourteen individuals.

Gaelchara is an innovative and novel scheme that aims to give Irish-language learners living in Cloich Cheann Fhaola an opportunity to practice Irish as a living, every-day, community language. Through the scheme, the Irish-language learner is given an opportunity to improve his or her spoken Irish by participating in a day-to-day activity or pastime in the company of a native speaker (his or her Gaelchara) in a Gaeltacht setting over a ten-month period. Among the pastimes and activities chosen by this year's winners are: training for a triathlon; devising a theatre performance as Gaeilge; organic farming; ecclesiastical study; painting outdoors and learning sean-nós singing.

Irish-Language Employee of the Year Award, Cloich Cheann Fhaola, 2019

Closing date: Friday 15 November, 2019.

The aim of these awards is to give recognition to an employee who does the most to promote the use of the Irish language in the workplace and with the public/customers, and who inspires others to use the language in the workplace, whether they be fellow employees or the public/customers.

Two awards are available

1. *Irish-Language Employee of the Year Award, Cloich Cheann Fhaola, 2019. Prize of €200 and a plaque.*
2. *The Young Irish-Language Employee of the Year Award, Cloich Cheann Fhaola, 2019 (for employees between the ages of 17 and 26 years of age). Prize of €100 and a plaque.*

The awards will be presented by the Irish-Language Ambassador for Cloich Cheann Fhaola, Caitlín Nic Aoidh.

Criteria

The awards will be judged using the following criteria:

- *The commitment of the employee as regards the promotion of the Irish-language in the workplace and with the public/customers.*
- *The efforts of the employee to ensure the Irish-language is more widely-spoken in the workplace and in the dealings with the public/customers.*
- *Entrants are required to provide evidence to the judging panel of the employee's commitment and work in promoting the language in the workplace and with the public.*

Making an application:

This is an opportunity for your business to gain positive publicity in both the English and Irish-language media.

There is no cost associated with entering the awards. The Language Planning Officer is available to help you with your application and to guide you through the application process.

To apply, fill in an application form and return it to the Language-Planning Officer. (the contact details are available below).

You can provide further information if you wish. For example, a package that gives evidence of how the employee promotes the language in the workplace or uses Irish in the workplace, etc.

Terms and conditions

- Irish-Language Employee of the Year Award is open to employees of businesses, companies or organisations that are based in the Language Planning area of Chloich Cheann Fhaola.
- The Irish-Language Young Employee of the Year Award is open to young people between the ages of 17 and 26 year old who are employees of businesses, companies or organisations that are based in the Language Planning area of Chloich Cheann Fhaola.
- Any company, business or organisation whose main work is the promotion of the Irish language is ineligible for this competition. As are companies or organisations who come under the remit of Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla 2003.
